MFP is a two-year process of six courses taken online through Columbia Theological Seminar alongside live cohort classes administered by the presbytery to begin the summer of 2021.

Online courses include:

- Reformed Theology
- Understanding Congregations (Systems)

Live/Zoom classes include:

- Preaching
- Self-Care
- Worship and Sacraments
- Pastoral Care
- Christian History
- Boundaries and Ethics

Cohort members will receive education for pastoral service in local congregations, to administer the Lord's Supper and Baptism, moderate a Session, vote in Presbytery Assembly, perform Christian marriage, engage in new and innovative ministries, lead classes and Bible studies, etc.

Cohort members who are interested in being commissioned for particular ministries within the Presbytery will meet with those who will guide them in that process.

Cost for the two-year program is about \$1,000 per cohort member. (courses/books)
